6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to law enforcement retirement;
8 amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-310.2, which relates
9 to administrative leave with pay; modifying allowable
10 administrative leave; and providing an effective
11 date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-310.2, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 2-310.2. Whenever any member of the Oklahoma Law
16 Enforcement Retirement System currently working in a position
17 identified by paragraph 6 of Section 2-300 of ~~Title 47 of the~~
18 ~~Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title who is enrolled in the Oklahoma Law
19 Enforcement Retirement System is unable to perform the member's
20 duties because of sickness or temporary disability caused or
21 sustained while in the discharge of the member's duty as such
22 member, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 840-2.21 of Title
23 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes or the provisions of Sections 11 and 12
24 of Title 85 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the member may be placed on

1 administrative leave with pay by the employing agency for a period
2 of ninety (90) days with the employing agency having the option of
3 extending the leave period for up to an additional ~~ninety (90)~~ one
4 hundred eight (180) days, not to exceed a total of ~~one hundred~~
5 ~~eighty (180)~~ two hundred seventy (270) days. The member's salary
6 and benefits shall continue to be paid by the employing agency
7 without any decrease or disruption of ~~said~~ the salary and benefits.
8 If the recovery period is longer than ~~one hundred eighty (180)~~ two
9 hundred seventy (270) days, the member shall use sick leave, annual
10 leave or other authorized leave. Should a member receiving a salary
11 under this section be eligible to receive and should the salary of
12 the member under this section exceed any temporary disability
13 benefit paid to the member under Section 1 et seq. of Title 85 of
14 the Oklahoma Statutes, the member shall transfer such temporary
15 disability benefits under Section 1 et seq. of Title 85 of the
16 Oklahoma Statutes to the employing agency while the member is sick
17 or temporarily disabled.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
