11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 4-104, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 4-104. $\frac{A}{A}$ A person, who, with intent and without
15	right to do so, injures or tampers with or in any way damages any
16	part or portion of any vehicle or implement of husbandry or in any
17	other manner damages any part or portion of said vehicle or
18	implement of husbandry any construction equipment or any
19	accessories, appurtenance or attachments thereto is guilty of a
20	misdemeanor:
21	1. A misdemeanor, if the injury or damage causes a loss which
22	has an aggregate value of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or less,
23	and upon conviction, the fine shall not exceed Five Thousand Dollars
24	<u>(\$5,000.00);</u>

- 2. A felony, if the injury or damage causes a loss which has an aggregate value of more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) but

 less than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00), and upon conviction, the fine shall not exceed Five Thousand Dollars

 (\$5,000.00);
 - 3. A felony, if the injury or damage causes a loss which has an aggregate value of more than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars

 (\$25,000.00), and upon conviction, the fine shall not exceed Ten

 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00); or
 - 4. A felony, if the person has two or more prior convictions

 for an offense under this section, notwithstanding the value of loss

 caused by the injury or damage, and upon conviction, the fine shall

 not exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).
 - (b) B. A person, who, without right to do so and with intent to commit a crime, tampers with or climbs into or upon a vehicle or implement of husbandry or construction equipment, whether it is in motion or at rest, attempts to manipulate any of the levers, starting mechanism, brakes or other mechanism or device of a vehicle or implement of husbandry while the same is at rest and unattended, or sets in motion any vehicle or implement of husbandry or construction equipment while the same is at rest and unattended is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, the fine shall not exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

1	(c) <u>C. In addition to any other punishment prescribed by law</u>
2	for violations of subsection A or B of this section, he or she is
3	liable for treble damages for the injury done, to be recovered in a
4	civil action by the owner of such property or public officer having
5	charge thereof.
