14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2368.33 of Title 68, unless

credit of the Recovering Oklahomans After Disaster Revolving Fund
created in subsection C of this section.

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving 3 С. fund to be designated the "Recovering Oklahomans After Disaster 4 5 Revolving Fund" and administered by the State Treasurer. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, 6 and shall consist of all the monies received by the State Treasurer 7 pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this section. All 8 9 monies accruing to the credit of the fund are appropriated and may 10 be budgeted and expended by the State Treasurer at the beginning of each fiscal year for the purpose of providing grants to Recovering 11 Oklahomans After Disaster for purposes of serving disaster survivors 12 13 by providing free home repairs in this state. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer 14 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the 15 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and 16 payment. 17

D. If a taxpayer makes a donation pursuant to subsection A of this section in error, such taxpayer may file a claim for refund at any time within three (3) years from the due date of the tax return. Such claims shall be filed pursuant to the provisions of Section 22 2373 of this title. Prior to the apportionment set forth in this section, an amount equal to the total amount of refunds made pursuant to this subsection during any one (1) year shall be

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1	deducted from the total donations received pursuant to this section
2	during the following year and such amount deducted shall be paid to
3	the State Treasurer and placed to the credit of the Income Tax
4	Withholding Refund Account.
