NEW LAW 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5025.1 of Title 63, unless there 15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall reimburse a contracted 17 provider for the diagnosis, consultation or treatment of a patient 18 delivered through telemedicine services on the same basis and at 19 least at the rate of reimbursement that the Authority is responsible 20 for coverage for the provision of the same, or substantially 21 similar, service through in-person diagnosis, consultation or 22 treatment. The Authority shall seek any federal approval necessary 23 to implement this section. As used in this section, "telemedicine"

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    shall have the same meaning as provided by Section 478 of Title 59
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    of the Oklahoma Statutes.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
