NEW LAW 14 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 90.23 of Title 25, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The second Saturday of December of each year is hereby 17 designated as "A Day of Remembrance", and the Governor is authorized 18 and requested to issue a proclamation commemorating the day and 19 honoring soldiers buried at the Fort Gibson National Cemetery and 20 the Fort Sill National Cemetery. On or before the second Saturday 21 in December, holiday wreaths will be placed on the graves of those 22 soldiers in remembrance of their service and to show respect during 23 24 the holiday season.
