14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 36-113, as								
15	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 23, O.S.L. 2017 (11 O.S. Supp.								
16	2018, Section 36-113), is amended to read as follows:								
17	Section 36-113. A. The Department of Transportation may, or								
18	the board of county commissioners of any county or federally								
19	recognized tribal government shall, by agreement with the governing								
20	body of a municipality having a population less than five thousand								
21	(5,000) persons, construct, improve, repair or maintain any of the								
22	streets of the municipality.								
23	B. The board of county commissioners may construct, improve,								
24 2 -	repair, or maintain any of the streets of a municipality having a								

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<sup>1</sup> population of less than five thousand (5,000) persons subject to <sup>2</sup> agreement between the governing bodies of the county and the <sup>3</sup> municipality without regard to whether the municipality has passed a <sup>4</sup> sales tax with proceeds earmarked to construct, improve, repair or <sup>5</sup> maintain any of the streets or roadways of such municipality.

The board of county commissioners may construct, improve, 7 repair or maintain any of the streets of a municipality having a 8 population of greater than five thousand (5,000) persons but less 9 than fifteen thousand (15,000) persons five thousand (5,000) persons 10 and greater if the municipality has passed a sales tax with the 11 proceeds earmarked to construct, improve, repair or maintain any of 12 the streets or roadways of such municipality provided that the 13 county has a population of less than one hundred fifty thousand 14 (150,000) persons.

15 D. The Notwithstanding any provision of this section, the board 16 of county commissioners may construct, improve, repair, or maintain 17 any of the streets of a municipality if the county has a population 18 in excess of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) persons according 19 to the most recent Federal Decennial Census. The agreements entered 20 into pursuant to the provisions of this subsection may be performed 21 without regard to whether the municipality has passed a sales tax 22 with proceeds earmarked to construct, improve, repair or maintain 23 any of the streets or roadways of such municipality.
