8	An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S. 2011, Section 36-113, as last amended by Section 1,
9	Chapter 23, O.S.L. 2017 (11 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 36-113), which relates to streets and roads;
10	modifying population requirement for the authorization of certain construction projects; and
11	providing an effective date.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 36-113, as
16	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 23, O.S.L. 2017 (11 O.S. Supp.
17	2018, Section 36-113), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 36-113. A. The Department of Transportation may, or
19	the board of county commissioners of any county or federally
20	recognized tribal government shall, by agreement with the governing
21	body of a municipality having a population less than five thousand
22	(5,000) persons, construct, improve, repair or maintain any of the
23	streets of the municipality.

B. The board of county commissioners may construct, improve, repair, or maintain any of the streets of a municipality having a population of less than five thousand (5,000) persons subject to agreement between the governing bodies of the county and the municipality without regard to whether the municipality has passed a sales tax with proceeds earmarked to construct, improve, repair or maintain any of the streets or roadways of such municipality.

C. The board of county commissioners may construct, improve, 8 9 repair or maintain any of the streets of a municipality having a 10 population of greater than five thousand (5,000) persons but less than fifteen thousand (15,000) persons five thousand (5,000) persons 11 12 and greater if the municipality has passed a sales tax with the proceeds earmarked to construct, improve, repair or maintain any of 13 the streets or roadways of such municipality provided that the 14 15 county has a population of less than one hundred fifty thousand 16 (150,000) persons.

The Notwithstanding any provision of this section, the board 17 D. of county commissioners may construct, improve, repair, or maintain 18 any of the streets of a municipality if the county has a population 19 in excess of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) persons according 20 to the most recent Federal Decennial Census. The agreements entered 21 into pursuant to the provisions of this subsection may be performed 22 without regard to whether the municipality has passed a sales tax 23
