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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5026.1 of Title 63, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority, to the extent
20	permissible under federal law, shall provide Medicaid coverage for
21	medically necessary pasteurized donor breast milk provided:
22	1. A physician, physician assistant or Advanced Practice
23	Registered Nurse licensed in this state signs an order stating that
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1 such milk is medically necessary for an infant Medicaid beneficiary; 2 and

- 3 2. a. the infant is medically or physically unable to
 4 receive maternal breast milk or participate in
 5 breastfeeding, or
 - b. the infant's mother is medically or physically unable to produce maternal breast milk in sufficient quantities.

9 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate Β. 10 rules to implement the provisions of this section including, but not 11 limited to, establishing infant birth weight and health conditions 12 that may make the provision of pasteurized donor breast milk 13 medically necessary and time limits for Medicaid coverage of 14 pasteurized donor breast milk. The Board may adopt a policy or 15 procedure to implement the provisions of this section while in the 16 process of promulgating rules; provided, such policy or procedure is 17 posted on the Internet website of the Authority prior to adoption of 18 the policy.

C. The Authority shall seek any federal approval necessary to implement this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

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1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
