An Act relating to higher education; amending 70 O.S. 2011, Section 3227, which relates to contracts with retired employees; removing intent language; modifying certain requirement for certain position; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Employment contracts

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 3227, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3227. ~~It is the intent of the Legislature that no~~ No institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall enter into a contract for consultant services with any person who has retired from employment with any institution for two (2) years after the retirement date of such person. Nothing in this section shall prohibit an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education from entering into a contract for a part-time teaching or research position of not more than ~~six semester hours or the equivalent thereof~~ twelve (12) semester hours per academic year with a person who has retired from employment with an institution within two (2) years after the retirement date of the person; provided that the earnings do not exceed the limitations on earnings pursuant to Section 17-116.10 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
