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- by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services. A school district board of education or charter school governing body may determine the method and manner in which to administer the test.
 - C. A student who does not obtain a passing score on the test required by subsection A of this section may retake the test until he or she obtains a passing score.
 - D. A school district or charter school shall document on the student's transcript that the student has met the requirement of subsection A of this section.
 - E. Students who have individualized education programs pursuant to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) shall be exempt from the requirements of this section.
 - F. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
