7	An Act relating to commercial driver licenses; defining terms; directing the Department of Public
8	Safety to adopt and prescribe certain rules and regulations; requiring annual inspections; requiring
9	commercial driver license training schools and instructors to obtain license; specifying licensing
10	requirements for schools and instructors; providing for the issuance and renewal of licenses; stating
11	fees; requiring annual background checks; providing for the cancelation, suspension, revocation and
12	refusal of licenses; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 811 of Title 47, unless there is
18	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	As used in Sections 1 through 7 of this act:
20	1. "Commercial driver license training school" means a business
21	enterprise conducted by an individual, association, partnership or
22	corporation, licensed by the Department of Public Safety that
23	charges a tuition for the education and training of persons to
24	operate a commercial motor vehicle, and prepares an applicant for

1 the written and skills portion of the examination for a Class A, B
2 or C commercial driver license; and

2. "Commercial driver license training instructor" means an employee of a commercial driver license training school who teaches, conducts classes, gives demonstrations or supervises the practice of persons learning to operate or drive commercial motor vehicles, and is licensed by the Department of Public Safety to administer the written and skills portion of the examination for a Class A, B or C commercial driver license.

10 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 812 of Title 47, unless there is 12 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The Department of Public Safety shall adopt and prescribe such 14 rules and regulations concerning the administration and enforcement 15 of this act as are necessary to carry out the intent of this act and 16 to protect the public. The Department shall conduct annual 17 inspections of the commercial driver license training school 18 facilities and equipment.

19 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 813 of Title 47, unless there is 21 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No commercial driver license training school shall beestablished unless such school applies for and obtains from the

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Department of Public Safety a license in the manner and form
 prescribed by the Department.

3 Regulations adopted by the Department shall state the Β. requirements for a commercial driver license training school 4 5 license, including requirements concerning location, equipment, courses of instruction, instructors, financial statements, schedule 6 7 of fees and charges, character and reputation of the operators and instructors, insurance in such sum and with such provisions as the 8 9 Department deems necessary to protect adequately the interests of 10 the public, and such other matters as the Department may prescribe for the protection of the public. 11

12 C. Every school offering instruction for a Class A, B or C 13 commercial driver license must provide for a minimum number of hours 14 of actual classroom and field driving instruction as determined by 15 the Department.

16 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 814 of Title 47, unless there is 18 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No person shall act as a commercial driver license training
 instructor unless such person applies for and obtains from the
 Department of Public Safety a license in the manner and form
 prescribed by the Department.

B. Rules promulgated by the Department shall state therequirements for a commercial driver license training instructor's

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1 license, including requirements concerning moral character, physical 2 condition, knowledge of the courses of instruction, motor vehicle 3 laws and safety principles and practices, previous personnel and 4 employment records, and such other matters as the Department may 5 prescribe for the protection of the public.

6 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 815 of Title 47, unless there is 8 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 All licenses issued pursuant to the provisions of this act shall expire on the last day of the calendar year and may be renewed upon 10 11 application to the Department of Public Safety as prescribed by 12 regulation. Each application for an original or renewal commercial driver license training school license shall be accompanied by a fee 13 of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00). Each application 14 for an original or renewal commercial driver license training 15 instructor's license shall be accompanied by a fee of One Thousand 16 Dollars (\$1,000.00). The license fees collected pursuant to this 17 section shall be deposited to the credit of the Department of Public 18 Safety Restricted Revolving Fund to be used for the purposes of this 19 act. No license fee shall be refunded in the event that the license 20 is denied, suspended, or revoked. 21

22 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 816 of Title 47, unless there is 24 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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The Department shall conduct an annual complete nationwide
 criminal history background check on each commercial driver license
 training instructor. The fees for the background check shall be
 borne by the commercial driver license training instructor.

5 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 817 of Title 47, unless there is 7 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Public Safety may cancel, suspend, revoke or 8 9 refuse to issue or renew a commercial driver license training school 10 or commercial driver license training instructor's license in any 11 case where the Department finds the licensee or applicant has not 12 complied with, or has violated, any of the provisions of this act or 13 any regulation adopted by the Department hereunder. Any canceled, suspended or revoked license shall be returned to the Department by 14 15 the licensee, and the holder of the license shall not be eligible to apply for a license under this act until twelve (12) months have 16 elapsed since the date of suspension or revocation. 17

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 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.

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
