11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 85A O.S. 2021, Section 67, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 67. A. Except as otherwise provided in this section,
15	notice of disability resulting from an occupational disease or
16	cumulative trauma shall be the same as in cases of accidental
17	injury.
18	B. Written notice shall be given to the employer of an
19	occupational disease or cumulative trauma by the employee, or a
20	representative of the employee in the case of incapacity or death,
21	within six (6) months after the first distinct manifestation of the
22	disease or cumulative trauma or within six (6) months after death.

1	C. The date of injury for cumulative trauma shall be the last
2	date of injurious exposure prior to the filing date of the
3	Employee's First Notice of Claim for Compensation.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
