16	B. Prosecutions for the crimes of first degree manslaughter and
17	second degree manslaughter shall be commenced within ten (10) years
18	after the discovery of the crime. For purposes of this subsection,
19	"discovery" means the date the crime is reported to a law
20	enforcement agency.
