15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause, and entire bill  
16 and insert:

18 "[ schools - school security alert systems - State  
19 Board of Education - list - minimum requirements of  
20 alert systems - codification - effective date -  
21 emergency ]

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-149.4 of Title 70, unless  
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. Each public school district shall have and implement a  
5 school security alert and response system.

6 B. The State Board of Education shall adopt a list of approved  
7 school security alert and response systems. At a minimum, an  
8 approved school security alert and response system shall:

9 1. Automatically alert designated school personnel when an  
10 emergency response is initiated on-site by smartphone application,  
11 phone call, text message, or other technology;

12 2. Provide emergency responders with floor plans, caller  
13 location, and other information to assist emergency responders  
14 during a 911 call; and

15 3. Integrate designated school personnel with emergency  
16 responders to provide real-time situational updates during an  
17 emergency.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-149.4 of Title 70, unless  
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A. Each school district in this state shall be authorized to  
14 issue a request for proposals and enter into a contract with a  
15 vendor to provide a security alert system for the safety and  
16 security of the district.

17 B. The security alert system shall:

18 1. Connect the caller with 9-1-1 emergency responders while  
19 simultaneously notifying designated school district personnel; and

20 2. Be available for use as a smartphone application.

21 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

22 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
23 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
