13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 805, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 805. All licenses, purchased or renewed after the
17	effective date of this act, shall expire on the last day of the
18	calendar year be valid for a four-year term and may be renewed upon
19	application to the Commissioner as prescribed by his or her
20	regulation. Each application for an original or renewal school
21	license shall be accompanied by a fee of Twenty-five Dollars
22	(\$25.00) One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Each application for an
23	original or renewal instructor's license shall be accompanied by a
24	fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) <u>Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)</u> . The license

1	fees collected pursuant to Sections 801 through 808 of this title
2	shall be remitted to the State Treasurer to be credited to the
3	General Revenue Fund in the State Treasury. No license fee shall be
4	refunded in the event that the license is rejected, suspended, or
5	revoked.
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
