An Act relating to protective services for the elderly and for incapacitated adults; directing the Department of Human Services to require certain training; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Training for Adult Protective Services specialists

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-114 of Title 43A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Human Services shall require all Adult Protective Services (APS) specialists to receive training regarding the recognition of individuals with cognitive impairment, effective intervention in cases involving the abuse and exploitation of individuals who are cognitively impaired and securing the safety of abused and exploited individuals with dementia.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
