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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 34.36, as
14	last amended by Section 3, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2016 (62 O.S. Supp.
15	2016, Section 34.36), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 34.36. A. On the first day of October preceding each
17	regular session of the Legislature, each state agency, including
18	those created or established pursuant to constitutional provisions,
19	shall report to the Director of the Office of Management and
20	Enterprise Services and the Chair and Vice Chair of the Legislative
21	Oversight Committee on State Budget Performance an itemized request
22	showing the amount needed for the ensuing fiscal year beginning with
23	the first day of July.
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B. The forms which must be used in making these reports shall
 be approved by the Director of the Office of Management and
 Enterprise Services and the Legislative Oversight Committee on State
 Budget Performance.

5 C. The forms shall be uniform, and shall clearly designate the6 information to be given.

7 D. The information provided shall include, but not be limited8 to:

9 1. A budget analysis of existing and proposed programs
10 utilizing performance-informed budgeting techniques. Such analysis
11 shall be included as a part of the estimate of funds needed;

12 2. A statement listing any other state, federal or local 13 agencies which administer a similar or cooperating program and an 14 outline of the interaction among such agencies;

15 3. A statement of the statutory authority for the missions and
16 quantified objectives of each program;

4. A description of the groups of people served by each programin the agency;

19 5. A quantification of the need for the program;

20 6. A description of the tactics which are intended to21 accomplish each objective;

22 7. A list of quantifiable program outcomes which measure the23 efficiency and effectiveness of each program;

24 8. A ranking of these programs by priority;

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9. Actual program expenditures for the current fiscal year and
 prior fiscal years and the number of personnel required to
 accomplish each program;

10. Revenues expected to be generated by each program, if any; 4 5 11. With respect to appropriated state agencies, a detailed listing of all employees and resources dedicated to the provision of 6 financial services including but not limited to procurement, 7 payroll, accounts receivable and accounts payable. The provisions 8 9 of this paragraph shall not be applicable to the Oklahoma State 10 Regents for Higher Education or to any institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education; and 11

12 12. A certification that following the effective date of this 13 act and prior to July 1, 2011, no expenditure shall have been made 14 or funds encumbered for the purchase, lease, lease-purchase or 15 rental of any computers, software, telecom, information technology 16 hardware, firmware or information technology services, including 17 support services without the prior written approval of the State 18 Comptroller or his or her designee.

E. These appropriated agencies shall make an itemized estimate of needs for the ensuing fiscal year and the following two (2) fiscal years and request for funds for the ensuing fiscal year and an estimate of the revenues from all sources to be received by the agency during the ensuing fiscal year and the following two (2) fiscal years.

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F. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
 Services shall submit to the Governor and the Legislative Oversight
 Committee on State Budget Performance no later than the fifth day of
 October a complete list of all spending agencies which have failed
 to submit budgets by October 1.

G. The reports required by this section shall include an
itemized listing of outstanding capital lease debt and estimated
capital lease needs for the ensuing fiscal year and the following
two (2) fiscal years, and shall be provided on forms prescribed by
the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

For the purposes of this section, "capital lease" means a 11 Η. lease-purchase agreement which provides an option for the State of 12 13 Oklahoma or its agencies to purchase property, including personal and real property, which is the subject thereof and/or a lease 14 agreement that provides an option for the State of Oklahoma or its 15 agencies to lease such property, which is the subject thereof, at a 16 nominal annual amount, after a period in which leased property is 17 rented at fair market value. 18

I. The provisions of this section shall not apply to CompSource
 Oklahoma if CompSource Oklahoma is operating pursuant to a pilot
 program authorized by Sections 3316 and 3317 of Title 74 of the
 Oklahoma Statutes.

J. Not later than January 1, the Director of the Office of
 Management and Enterprise Services shall publish a shared services

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1 cost-performance assessment report documenting the amount of each 2 state agency's cost for providing shared services. The lowest 3 ranking state agencies shall enter into a contract with the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for the provision of shared 4 5 financial services, provided that the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services determines that implementation of 6 such a contract would be feasible and documents that the contractual 7 agreement will result in cost savings or efficiencies to the state. 8 9 Contracts required by this subsection shall be entered into at the 10 start of the next fiscal year. When a state agency is contracted 11 with the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for the 12 provision of shared financial services, the agency may discontinue 13 using shared services when documentation showing that the agency can provide the services at a lower cost to the state is provided to and 14 15 approved by the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. As used in this subsection, "shared services" means 16 process, resource utilization or action as defined by administrative 17 rule. On a yearly basis the Director of the Office of Management 18 and Enterprise Services shall compile and publish a report 19 documenting the cost savings resulting from shared services 20 The provisions of this subsection shall not be 21 contracts. applicable to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education or to 22 any institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher 23 Education. 24

1	K. In addition to the requirements of subsection A of this
2	section, for the fiscal year which begins on July 1, 2018, and for
3	each fiscal year thereafter, the State Department of Education shall
4	develop and annually update an eight-year plan of action. The plan
5	shall reflect any known changes in state, federal or local policy.
6	The plan shall provide detailed estimates of the expenditures
7	required to accomplish the agency mission over the following eight-
8	year period, including but not limited to expenditures for
9	administration and staffing, equipment and supplies and other
10	relevant program costs. In addition, the plan shall provide an
11	estimate of changes in the number of students to be served over the
12	eight-year time period.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
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
