1	B. Remediation required by subsection A of this section may
2	include but is not limited to:
3	1. Extended instructional time during the school day;
4	2. A summer academy;
5	3. Tutoring;
6	4. Online coursework;
7	5. Repetition of any course in which the student has
8	demonstrated academic deficiency by scoring below the benchmarks in
9	subject-area portions of the ACT or SAT; or
10	6. Other supplementary services.
11	$\underline{\text{C.}}$ Nothing in subsection A of this section shall be construed
12	to require that a teacher providing instruction in the remediation
13	course be certified in any subject matter that is tested on the ACT
14	or SAT exam.
15	D. The State Board of Education may promulgate rules to
16	implement the provisions of this section.
17	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
18	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
20	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
