14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4315 of Title 70, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	Any public or private institution of higher education that is a
19	member of a governing authority shall have a cause of action against
20	a third party who engages or conspires with another to engage in
21	conduct in violation of the rules of the governing authority that
22	causes the educational institution to incur sanctions by the
23	governing authority or other economic penalties or losses. The
24	educational institution may recover damages in the amount of the

1	sanctions, penalties or economic losses incurred as a result of the
2	conduct of the third party, and reasonable attorney fees and costs.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
