11	contracting for use of photo monitoring devices; defining terms; providing for codification; and
12	providing an effective date.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-226 of Title 47, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. No state agency, county, municipality or political
19	subdivision may contract with any private corporation to provide for
20	the use of any photo monitoring device to detect any traffic control
21	signal violation.
22	B. As used in this section, the term "photo monitoring device"
23	means a stationary, unmanned device used with a lighted traffic
24	control device to detect a traffic control signal violation and

1	captures photographic identification of the vehicle that results in
2	the issuance of a citation against the registrant, rather than the
3	driver, of the vehicle.
4	C. As used in this section, the term "traffic control signal"
5	means any device, whether manually, electronically or mechanically
6	operated, by which traffic is alternately directed to stop and
7	proceed.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
