7	An Act relating to the state Medicaid program;
8	requiring coverage of certain breast pumps; specifying limits of coverage; requiring breast pumps

11	emergency.
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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5026.1 of Title 63, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall provide coverage under
18	the state Medicaid program for breast pumps dispensed pursuant to a
19	valid prescription by a physician, physician assistant or Advanced
20	Practice Registered Nurse including manual pumps, electric pumps or
21	battery-powered pumps. The state Medicaid program shall cover one
22	breast pump per pregnancy including tubing or other necessary parts.
23	A breast pump must meet minimum specifications prescribed by the
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1	Authority in order to qualify for reimbursement. The Authority
2	shall seek any federal approval necessary to implement this section.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
4	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
