6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to court clerks; requiring court  
8 clerks to set certain hearings; providing exception;  
9 authorizing court to reschedule certain hearings;  
10 requiring notice; providing for codification; and  
11 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 35.2 of Title 12, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 In any case or proceeding in the district courts, the court  
17 clerk at the time of the filing of a petition or information shall  
18 set the date and time for hearing of all motions other than  
19 expedited or emergency motions, and provide notice to all parties.  
20 The district court judge may reschedule the date and time set by the  
21 court clerk, and provide notice of the new date and time to all  
22 parties.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
