SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 51.4 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State of Oklahoma shall establish a program to provide assistance for the funeral expenses of all members of the National Guard, police, state troopers, firefighters and first responders who have died in the line of duty while under state orders. The program shall provide a grant for funeral expenses for any person who qualifies as determined by the Oklahoma Homeland Security Director.

Maximum reimbursement shall not exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

The deceased must be a resident of the State of Oklahoma. The Oklahoma Homeland Security Director or his or her designee shall make final approval of all applications. The approving authority shall determine whether the deceased meets eligibility criteria and approve funds to defray funeral costs. Reimbursement will be paid from the Oklahoma Homeland Security Revolving Fund. Rules and application processes for the implementation of this program shall be promulgated by the Oklahoma Homeland Security Director. SECTION 2.
