12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3120 of Title 74, unless there
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. During each regular session of the Legislature, any member
16	may request, by proper passage of a resolution introduced by either
17	the Senate or the House of Representatives, a statement of legal
18	authority for a specific facet of operations of the agency, as
19	specified in the resolution. The legal authority shall include
20	reference to any constitutional provision, statute, and/or rule and
21	regulation. The resolution shall direct delivery to the agency and
22	its director or listed head of agency. The director or head of
23	agency shall have ten (10) business days upon receipt, unless
24	extended by request, in which to deliver by regular mail or in

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electronic format the applicable legal authority as specified in the resolution. The delivery shall be made to the author or authors of the resolution unless otherwise directed in the resolution. Any director or head of agency that does not submit a в. response pursuant to this section may be subject to impeachment or removal from office as provided by law. SECTION 2.
