NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3120 of Title 74, unless there 13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 14 15 During each regular session of the Legislature, any member Α. 16 may request, by proper passage of a resolution introduced by either 17 the Senate or the House of Representatives, a statement of legal authority for a specific facet of operations of the agency, as 18 specified in the resolution. The legal authority shall include 19 reference to any constitutional provision, statute, and/or rule and 20 regulation. The resolution shall direct delivery to the agency and 21 its director or listed head of agency. The director or head of 22 agency shall have ten (10) business days upon receipt, unless 23 extended by request, in which to deliver by regular mail or in 24

2	resolution. The delivery shall be made to the author or authors of

4	B. Any director or head of agency that does not submit a
