Nine Hundred Thirty-nine Dollars and sixty-nine cents (\$9,939.69),

shall be considered a paid firefighter and must meet the physical and agility requirements pursuant to Section 49-116 of this title to continue as an active member of the System. Credited service earned as a paid firefighter pursuant to this section shall not be considered actual experience as a paid firefighter for purposes of meeting the qualifications of a paid fire chief as provided in Section 29-102 of this title. No fire department of a participating municipality shall employ a volunteer firefighter from another fire department to perform services relating to firefighting for any compensation of any kind.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 49-143.8 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any member of the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and Retirement System receiving benefits as of June 30, 2024, who continues to receive benefits on or after July 1, 2024, shall receive a benefit equal to Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each year of credited service not to exceed thirty (30) years of service.
