An Act relating to hearing aids; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-1751, which relates to license fees; requiring applicants to be responsible for certain costs; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Licensure and certification of hearing aid providers

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-1751, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-1751. Fees for licenses issued by the State Board of Health to practice the fitting and dealing of hearing aids shall be set by the $\underline{\text{State}}$ Board of Health at rates not less than the following schedule:

Application for a Temporary Permit	\$ 15.00
Examination Fee	35.00
Renewal of a License	50.00
Renewal within thirty-day grace period	75.00
Renewal after expiration	100.00

Any fee schedule changes must be submitted to the Legislature for approval or rejection under the Administrative Procedures Act.

Applicants for examinations shall be responsible for the full cost of examinations, re-examinations, and background checks relating to licensing and certification.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
