- 2. Has satisfied the admission standards as determined by The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for first-time entering students for the appropriate type of institution; and
- 3. Is the child of a parent or legal guardian who has vested in the Oklahoma Teachers' Retirement System, as provided for in Section 17-105 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, as of the effective date of this act.
- B. A waiver granted by this section shall not be allowed for courses or other postsecondary units taken more than five (5) years after the student's first semester of postsecondary enrollment.
- C. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
