No alien or any person who is not a foreign 18 citizen of the United States shall acquire title to or own land in 19 the State of Oklahoma this state either directly or indirectly 20 through a business entity or trust, except as hereinafter provided, 21 but he or she shall have and enjoy in the State of Oklahoma this 22 state such rights as to personal property as are, or shall be 23

such nation with the United States, except as the same may be affected by the provisions of this act Section 121 et seq. of this title or the Constitution of this state. Any person who knowingly acquires title to land in violation of this section shall upon conviction be guilty of a felony.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 60 O.S. 2021, Section 122, is amended to read as follows:

Section 122. This article shall not apply to lands now owned in

this state by aliens foreign citizens so long as they are held by the present owners, nor to any alien foreign citizen who is or shall take up bona fide residence in this state: and; provided, that any alien foreign citizen who is or shall become a bona fide resident of the State of Oklahoma shall have the right to acquire and hold lands in this state upon the same terms as citizens of the State of Oklahoma during the continuance of such bona fide residence of such alien foreign citizen in this state: Provided, that if any such resident alien foreign citizen shall cease to be a bona fide inhabitant of this state, such alien foreign citizen shall have five (5) years one (1) year from the time he or she ceased to be such bona fide resident in which to alienate such lands.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
