7	An Act relating to the state Medicaid program; requiring coverage of medically necessary pasteurized
8	donor human milk under certain conditions; directing promulgation of rules; authorizing adoption of

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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5026.1 of Title 63, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority, to the extent
18	permissible under federal law, shall provide Medicaid coverage for
19	medically necessary pasteurized donor human milk in a home setting;
20	provided:
21	1. A physician, physician assistant or Advanced Practice
22	Registered Nurse licensed in this state signs an order stating that
23	such milk is medically necessary for an infant Medicaid beneficiary;
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- 2. a. The infant is medically or physically unable to
 receive maternal breast milk or participate in
 breastfeeding, or
- b. The infant's mother is medically or physically unable
 to produce maternal breast milk in sufficient
 quantities; and

3. Such milk is provided by a donor human milk bank that
adheres to quality standards of and is accredited by the Human Milk
Banking Association of North America or such other standards or
accreditation as may be required by the Authority.

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate 11 Β. 12 rules to implement the provisions of this section including, but not 13 limited to, establishing infant birth weight and health conditions that may make the provision of pasteurized donor human milk 14 medically necessary and time limits for Medicaid coverage of 15 pasteurized donor human milk. The Board may adopt a policy or 16 procedure to implement the provisions of this section while in the 17 process of promulgating rules; provided, such policy or procedure is 18 posted on the Internet website of the Authority prior to adoption of 19 the policy. 20

21 C. The Authority shall seek any federal approval necessary to 22 implement this section.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

2	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
