The legal authority shall include 21 reference to any constitutional provision, statute, and/or rule and 22 regulation. The resolution shall direct delivery to the agency and 23 its director or listed head of agency. The director or head of 24

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1	agency shall have ten (10) days upon receipt, unless extended by
2	request, in which to deliver by regular mail or in electronic format
3	the applicable legal authority as specified in the resolution. The
4	delivery shall be made to the author or authors of the resolution.
5	C. Any director or head of agency that does not submit a
