AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; providing immunity from liability for school district employees for providing certain elective course; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-101.3 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A school district and its employees and agents shall incur no liability as a result of providing an elective course in the objective study of religion or the Bible.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
