10	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2021, Section 35.3, is
11	amended to read as follows:
12	Section 35.3. As used in the Information Technology
13	Consolidation and Coordination Act:
14	1. "Appropriated state agency" means any state agency that
15	receives funding through the annual legislative appropriations
16	process;
17	2. "Information technology assets" means any equipment or
18	interconnected system or subsystem of equipment that is used in the
19	acquisition, storage, manipulation, management, movement, control,
20	display, switching, interchange, transmission, or reception of data
21	or information. The term shall include computers, ancillary
22	equipment, software, firmware and similar procedures, services,
23	including support services and consulting services, software
24	development, and related resources, and shall further include

2	communication	or information systems to multiple physical locations;

8	authority or institution of the executive branch of state government
9	excluding institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher
10	Education, the Oklahoma Municipal Power Authority, the Oklahoma
11	State Regents for Higher Education, the Oklahoma State Bureau of
12	Investigation, District Attorneys Council, the Office of the
13	Attorney General, the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector, and
14	the telecommunications network known as OneNet.
15	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
