An Act relating to prescription drugs; defining terms; providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.21 of Title 36, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering reads as follows:
As used in this act:
1. "Opioid analgesic drug product" means a drug product in the
opioid drug class prescribed to treat moderate to severe pain or
other conditions, whether in immediate release or extended
release/long-acting form and whether or not combined with other drug
substances to form a single drug product or dosage form;
2. "Abuse-deterrent opioid analgesic drug product" means a
brand or generic opioid analgesic drug product approved by the U.S.
Food and Drug Administration with abuse-deterrence labeling claims

1	that indicate the drug product is expected to result in a meaningful
2	reduction in abuse;
3	3. "Cost sharing" means any coverage limit, copayment,
4	coinsurance, deductible, or other out-of-pocket expense
5	requirements;
6	4. "Health plan" means any plan or arrangement as defined in
7	subsection C of Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
