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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 847 of Title 74, unless there is
15	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. Public employees shall not strike or engage in an organized
17	work stoppage against the state or any political subdivision of this
18	state.
19	B. A public employee who violates subsection A of this act
20	automatically forfeits his or her employment with the state or
21	political subdivision, all civil service rights, pensions,
22	reemployment rights, and benefits, as a result of public employment.
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1	C. A public employee who is employed as a teacher or
2	administrator and violates subsection A of this act shall have his
3	or her state teaching certificates revoked.
4	D. The right of an individual to cease work may not be abridged
5	if the individual is not acting in concert with others in an
6	organized work stoppage.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
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
