17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry
19	shall review methods of remote viewing or other digital inspection

21	B. If the Department determines a suitable method of remote
22	viewing or other digital inspection technology upon completion of

2 of the technology.

C. Upon approval by the federal agency governing meat and poultry inspection, the Department shall promulgate rules to implement the use of remote viewing or other digital inspection technology.

D. The use of remote viewing or other digital inspection
technology shall be restricted to inspections of meat and poultry
products sold only in intrastate commerce, unless the federal agency
governing meat and poultry inspection approves it for interstate
commerce.

E. The videos from remote viewing or digital inspection
obtained pursuant to this section shall be kept confidential by the
Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
