16	ballot pursuant to Section 14-110.1 of this title shall be
17	responsible for marking the <del>ballots</del> <u>ballot</u> or directing a person
18	chosen by the voter to mark the <del>ballots</del> <u>ballot</u> in accordance with
19	the provisions of Section 7-123.3 of this title and as prescribed by
20	the Secretary of the State Election Board $\div$ .
21	2. The voter shall seal the ballots in the plain opaque
22	envelope <del>;</del> .
23	3. The voter shall fill out completely and sign the affidavit
24	or direct a person chosen by the voter to sign the affidavit, <del>such</del>

<sup>1</sup> whose name and address of residence shall be printed on the <sup>2</sup> affidavit.

3 <u>4. The signature to of the voter shall</u> be witnessed by two 4 persons, who did not sign the affidavit <u>on behalf of the voter</u>, 5 whose <u>printed name</u>, signature and address <u>of residence</u> shall appear 6 on the affidavit<del>;</del>.

7 <u>5. The voter shall</u> seal the plain opaque envelope inside the 8 envelope bearing the affidavit and return both envelopes, sealed 9 inside the return envelope, by United States mail or by a private 10 mail service, provided such service has delivery documentation, to 11 the county election board in the same manner described in Section 12 14-108 of this title.

B. No person, except members of absentee voting boards, shall witness the signature of more than five affidavits of persons who swear they are physically incapacitated and unable to vote in person at their precinct on election day. No person who is a candidate for an office on the ballot or who is related within the third degree of consanguinity or affinity to a candidate on the ballot may witness any absentee ballot affidavit.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
