AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-112, is amended to read as follows: 16 Section 6-112. A. Every licensee shall have his or her driver 17 license in his or her immediate possession at all times when 18 operating a motor vehicle and shall display the same upon. Upon 19 demand of a peace officer, the licensee shall produce and provide 20 physical possession of the driver license to the peace officer. 21 person violating this subsection shall, upon conviction, be guilty 22 of a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided for in Section 23 17-101 of this title. 24

1	B. Any person charged with violating this section who produces
2	in court, on or before the court date, a driver license issued to
3	him or her and valid at the time of his or her arrest shall be
4	entitled to dismissal of such charge without payment of court costs
5	and fine.
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
