10	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-106.1, is
11	amended to read as follows:
12	Section 6-106.1. If funds are appropriated to the A. The State
13	Board of Education shall allocate funds to school districts for
14	Mentor Teacher Stipends, the The funds shall be distributed by the
15	Board to the school districts to provide a stipend of not more than
16	Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per year for each mentor teacher as
17	defined in Section 6-182 of this title. In addition to the
18	distribution of the five-hundred-dollar stipend, each district shall
19	also receive the district's contribution amount necessary to meet
20	the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (F.I.C.A.) requirements.
21	B. A mentor teacher shall provide guidance, support, coaching,
22	and assistance to a teacher in his or her first year of teaching at
23	an employing school district, regardless of the length of time the
24	teacher has been certified.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
