14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
17	There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
18	Emergency Management from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
19	the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
20	ending June 30, 2024, the sum of Fifty Million Dollars
21	(\$50,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to be
22	deposited in the Oklahoma School Security Revolving Fund created
23	pursuant to Section 51.2c of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes to
24 27	administer the Oklahoma School Security Grant Program created

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 51.2b, as
amended by Section 5, Chapter 302, O.S.L. 2022 (74 O.S. Supp. 2022,
Section 51.2b), is amended to read as follows:

Section 51.2b. A. This section shall be known and may be cited
as the "Oklahoma School Security Grant Program Act".

B. The Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management shall
 solicit proposals for and make grants for the enhancement of campus
 security at institutions of higher learning, technology center
 schools, public schools, and private schools.

C. The goals and objectives of the Oklahoma School Security Grant Program are to:

15 1. Increase the awareness of the public and educational 16 institutions of the risks, threats, and vulnerabilities of school 17 campuses as well as mitigation strategies;

18 2. Incentivize participation in school security training 19 programs designed to assess campus risks, threats, and 20 vulnerabilities;

3. Provide assistance to institutions of higher learning, technology center schools, public schools, and private schools initiating or implementing school security plans, programs, and activities; and

1 4. Build upon the success of the pilot Education Grant Program 2 established by the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security. 3 D. 1. The Department shall determine grant project criteria 4 and establish a process for the consideration of proposals. The 5 proposals shall be considered on a statewide competitive basis among 6 peer institutions. 7 2. Oklahoma School Security Grant Program awards funded 8 pursuant to Section 1 of this act beginning July 1, 2023, shall be 9 used by public schools or private schools serving students in grades 10 pre-kindergarten through twelve for the following purposes: 11 the salaries and/or benefits of school security a. 12 personnel, 13 conducting risk and vulnerability assessments and b. 14 behavioral threat assessments and implementing 15 modifications based on assessment results, 16 security technology, с. 17 updating school building security, and d. 18 developing emergency response plans with local law е. 19 enforcement agencies and emergency medical service 20 providers. 21 On or before January 1, 2010, and each year thereafter, the Ε. 22 Department shall prepare an annual report on the Oklahoma School 23 Security Grant Program and submit the report to the Governor, the 24 _ _
