16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1720, is			
18	amended to read as follows:			
19	Section 1720. <u>A.</u> Any person in this state who shall steal:			
20	1. Steal a motor vehicle, an aircraft, automobile or other			
21	automotive driven vehicle, construction equipment or, farm			
22	equipment, self-propelled farm equipment or trailer;			
23	2. Maliciously damage a motor vehicle, aircraft, construction			
24	equipment, farm equipment, self-propelled farm equipment or trailer;			

1 3. Buy, receive, possess, conceal or obtain control of a motor 2 vehicle, aircraft, construction equipment, farm equipment, self-3 propelled farm equipment or trailer knowing or having reason to know 4 the same to have been stolen; or 5 4. Take motor vehicle, aircraft, construction equipment, farm 6 equipment, self-propelled farm equipment or trailer without the 7 authority of the owner and steals any of its parts or accessories, shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony, and upon 8 9 conviction shall be punished by confinement in the State 10 Penitentiary punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the 11 Department of Corrections for a term of not less than three (3) 12 years, nor more than twenty (20) years, or by a fine in an amount that is equal to three times the value of the property that was 13 stolen but not more than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars 14 15 (\$500,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment and shall be ordered to pay restitution pursuant to Section 991f of Title 22 of 16 the Oklahoma Statutes. 17 B. Any person who purchases or receives a used or secondhand 18 motor vehicle, aircraft, construction equipment, farm equipment, 19 self-propelled farm equipment or trailer shall obtain a bill of sale 20 or title of ownership from the seller as proof of purchase that the 21 person purchased or received the item from the seller. 22 SECTION 2. REPEALER 47 O.S. 2011, Sections 4-102 and 4-23 103, are hereby repealed. 24
