SENATE BILL 525 By: Boren

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to conduct of elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011, Section 7-130, which relates to commission of watchers; requiring secretary of county election board to provide list of commissioned watchers to state party chairs; clarifying statutory language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 7-130, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7-130. Any candidate or any recognized political party shall be entitled to have a watcher present at any place where an official count is being conducted. Such The watcher must shall be commissioned in writing by the candidate, or by the chair of the recognized political party of the county in which the watcher is being authorized. Such The commission must shall be filed with the secretary of the appropriate county election board no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday preceding the election. The secretary of the county election board shall provide a list of all commissioned poll watchers to the state chair of all recognized political parties

prior to the election. Watchers must subscribe to an oath to observe all laws and rules prescribed for watchers as hereinafter provided in this section. Such The oath must shall be administered by the inspector of the precinct in which the watcher is authorized. Watchers shall be entitled to observe the voting device both before the polls are opened and after the polls are closed; provided, further, that such watchers shall not be present at the polling place at other times. Watchers may be commissioned to observe voting device testing and to accompany personnel assigned to repair or maintain machines during the period of the election. In such case, the watchers but shall be limited to observing the repair or maintenance work being performed and making a written record of such work. Any watcher who violates the law prescribed for watchers shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
