16	A. For each live birth in this state for which a birth
17	certificate is issued, the birth certificate shall include
18	provisions to designate the citizenship of the biological parent or
19	parents of the child and provisions to designate the citizenship of
20	the child.
21	B. Provisions to designate the citizenship of the child shall
22	be limited to one or more of the following:
23	1. United States citizenship;
24	2. Oklahoma citizenship;

1 3. Tribal citizenship or membership; or 2 4. Foreign national/non-United States citizen. 3 С. For any child born to parents neither of which are citizens 4 of the United States, no United States or Oklahoma citizenship shall 5 be granted to the child and the only designation permitted on the 6 birth certificate shall be the designation provided in paragraph 4 7 of subsection B of this section. 8 SECTION 2.
