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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 803 of Title 17, unless there is
17	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. As used in this section, "DER utility" means any company
19	that produces, delivers or furnishes retail electric current for
20	light, heat or power to a customer through a power purchase
21	agreement with a customer provided that:
22	1. Generation occurs on the property of the customer that is
23	contiguous with the use of that power; and
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2. Generation shall not exceed one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the previous annual load of the customer.

- B. A customer of a DER utility shall be limited to schools, as defined in Section 1-106 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes or school districts, as defined in Section 1-108 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statues.
- C. A DER utility operating under this section shall have no condemnation authority.
- D. A DER utility shall not be subject to Section 158.21, et seq. of Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes provided that the DER utility:
 - 1. Files an application with the Corporation Commission;
- 2. Submits an annual report on power generated to the Commission;
- 3. Receives approval from the applicable rate-setting entity the DER Utility would operate within; and
- 4. Complies with any additional requirement established by the Commission.
- E. The Corporation Commission shall promulgate rules as necessary to implement this act.
- F. This act shall be valid for a term of ten (10) years, at which time a report of work shall be issued by the Office of the Secretary of Energy and Environment within one (1) year, for

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1	consideration and determination of continuance of the provisions of
2	this act.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
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
