13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2011, Section 4-113, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 4-113. A. Legal residents who are not the individuals
16	excepted from the license requirement as provided in subsection B of
17	Section 4-112 of this title may purchase an annual combination
18	hunting/fishing license from the Director or agents of the Director.
19	B. The fee for each combination hunting/fishing license issued
20	under this section shall be:
21	1. For legal residents eighteen (18) years of age and older for
22	a license that expires <del>on December 31 of the year purchased</del> <u>one year</u>
23	from the date of purchase - Forty-one Dollars (\$41.00);

2. For residents eighteen (18) years of age and older for a license that expires on June 30 of the fiscal year purchased one year from the date of purchase - Fifty-two Dollars ($52.00);
```

- 3. For legal residents sixteen (16) or seventeen (17) years of age for a license that expires on December 31 of the year purchased one year from the date of purchase Thirteen Dollars (\$13.00); and
- 4. For legal residents sixteen (16) or seventeen (17) years of age for a license that expires on June 30 of the fiscal year purchased one year from the date of purchase Eighteen Dollars (\$18.00).
- C. Of the fees collected pursuant to the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of subsection B of this section, Five Dollars (\$5.00) of the license fee shall be for the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp and shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund created pursuant to the provisions of Section 4-141 of this title.

  SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
