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| 13 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: |
| 14 | SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified |
| 15 | in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 181 of Title 53, unless there is |
| 16 | created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: |
| 17 | A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Cultural |
| 18 | Districts Initiative Act". |
| 19 | B. For purposes of the Cultural Districts Initiative Act: |
| 20 | 1. "Cultural district" means a mixed-use area of a community, |
| 21 | either rural or urban, in which a high concentration of arts and |
| 22 | cultural facilities or activities serves as the anchor of |
| 23 | attraction. Cultural districts may do any of the following: |

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- a. attract artists, creative entrepreneurs, creative industries and cultural enterprises to stimulate commerce,
- b. encourage entrepreneurship and small business development by incentivizing the establishment of new and relocating businesses in the community,
- c. establish and promote marketable tourism assets highlighting the distinct cultural identity of the community and attracting in-state, out-of-state and international visitors,
- d. preserve the community's authentic cultural identity by highlighting the region's existing artists and cultural traditions,
- e. provide opportunities for and mechanisms to recruit and sustain new artists, creative industries and organizations,
- f. offer arts and cultural programming and events that build a sense of community and foster cross-cultural understanding,
- g. celebrate the community's uniquely-built environment, encouraging the preservation and reuse of historic buildings and other culturally significant structures, and

h. enhance the quality of life for residents and attract
a well-educated and creative workforce to the
community; and

- 2. "Certified cultural district" means a cultural district that has been certified by the Oklahoma Arts Council through a competitive application process.
- C. The Oklahoma Arts Council shall administer the Cultural Districts Initiative Act. The Oklahoma Arts Council shall have powers and duties as follows:
 - 1. To implement the Cultural Districts Initiative Act;
- 2. To establish a competitive application process for participation in a cultural district development program that assists communities with further developing existing cultural assets;
- 3. To establish a competitive application and renewal process for certification as a state-designated certified cultural district;
- 4. To provide, whenever possible, state supported assistance for both developing and certified cultural districts including, but not limited to:
 - a. technical assistance in program development and marketing,
 - b. identifying and facilitating local access to other relevant non-profit, state and federal resources and funding opportunities, and

- c. finding or making referrals to professional service providers that may assist in a district's activities; and
- 5. To collaborate with other public agencies and private entities to enhance visibility and ensure broad and equitable benefits for certified cultural districts.

- D. Subject to funds available, the Legislature may appropriate funds to the Oklahoma Arts Council for purposes of the Cultural Districts Initiative Act.
- E. The Oklahoma Arts Council may solicit and receive monies, gifts, donations, bequests, grants and other resources from any public or private source for purposes of the Cultural Districts

 Initiative Act. The Oklahoma Arts Council may expend any monies received pursuant to the Cultural Districts Initiative Act for any purpose it deems necessary pursuant to the authority of the Cultural Districts Initiative Act.
- F. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Arts Council to be designated the "Cultural Districts Initiative Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Arts Council from all state appropriated funds and any monies, gifts, donations, bequests, grants and other sources of funds from any public or private source for the benefit of the Cultural Districts Initiative Act. All

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    monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated
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    and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Arts Council for
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    the purpose of the Cultural Districts Initiative Act. Expenditures
    from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
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    Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
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    Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
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    approval and payment.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
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
