15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 508 of Title 69, unless there is
18	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	The Department of Transportation shall have the authority to
20	make additions to the state highway system without a corresponding
21	removal of mileage in the following circumstances:
22	1. The addition of highway miles will improve public safety;
23	2. There are local, private or other non-state resources
24	contributed toward the capital costs of the addition;

1 3. Prior to the addition of highway miles, the performance metrics of the regional highway system, developed pursuant to 2 Section 45.3 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, are determined by 3 the Department of Transportation to be adequate in the strategic 4 5 qoal areas of: achieving and sustaining less than one percent (1%) 6 a. structurally deficient bridges, 7 b. increasing the percentage of highway lane miles in 8 9 good condition, с. decreasing the miles of rural two lane roads with 10 deficient shoulders, as defined in Section 241 of 11 12 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and d. decreasing traffic fatalities; 13 The addition of highway miles can be shown to have a 4. 14 15 positive local or regional economic impact; 5. The Department determines that the resources required for 16 long term operation and maintenance exist; and 17 The addition of highway miles is determined to be for the 6. 18 benefit of the general public. 19 20 SECTION 2.
