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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 2021, Section 604, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 604. The Director of the Department of Human Services
19	shall, within the constraints of funding appropriated to the
20	Department, maintain a Family Support Program for children with
21	severe developmental disabilities who reside in their family homes
22	in accordance with the following criteria:
23	1. The family member resides with the family;
24	2. The family resides in <del>the State of Oklahoma</del> this state;

1 3. The gross adjusted income of the family for the year 2 immediately preceding the date of application for the assistance did not exceed Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00) three hundred 3 4 percent (300%) of the federal poverty level (FPL) guidelines; 5 4. The family is headed by a biological parent, adoptive parent, or legal guardian of the eligible family member; provided, 6 however, that if the eligible family member lives with an adoptive 7 parent or parents who already receive adoption subsidy from any 8 9 source on behalf of the applicant, the family cannot receive family 10 support assistance authorized by this section; and 5. The family or family member does not receive Medicaid Home 11 12 and Community-based Waiver Services. 13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023. SECTION 3.
