9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.
11 2011, Section 150.23, as amended by Section 1,
12 Chapter 319, O.S.L. 2014 (74 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section
13 150.23), which relates to certain retired state
14 personnel; authorizing certain officers and agents of
15 the Oklahoma Department of Corrections to retain
16 certain items after retirement; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.23, as
20 amended by Section 1, Chapter 319, O.S.L. 2014 (74 O.S. Supp. 2014,
21 Section 150.23), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 150.23. A. An officer, investigator, or agent of the
23 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the Oklahoma State Bureau of
24 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Department of Wildlife
Conservation, the Law Enforcement Division of the Oklahoma Horse
Racing Commission, the State Fire Marshal's Office, the Oklahoma

1 Tourism and Recreation Department, the Office of Inspector General
2 and the Oklahoma Child Support Services divisions of the Department
3 of Human Services, a Probation and Parole officer or Internal
4 Affairs agent of the Department of Corrections, law enforcement
5 officers employed by the Grand River Dam Authority or the office of
6 a district attorney shall be entitled to receive, upon retirement by
7 reason of length of service, the continued custody and possession of
8 the sidearm and badge carried by such officer, investigator, or
9 agent immediately prior to retirement.

10 B. An officer, investigator, or agent specified in subsection A
11 of this section may be entitled to receive, upon retirement by
12 reason of disability, the continued custody and possession of the
13 sidearm and badge carried by such officer or agent immediately prior
14 to retirement upon written approval of the applicable Director of
15 the appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or district
16 attorney.

17 C. Custody and possession of the sidearm and badge of an
18 officer, investigator, or agent who dies while employed by any
19 Bureau, Department, Commission, or office specified in subsection A
20 of this section may be awarded by the applicable Director of the
21 appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or office to the spouse
22 or next of kin of the deceased officer, investigator, or agent.

23 D. A correctional officer, ~~a probation and parole officer or an~~
24 ~~internal affairs agent~~ of the Oklahoma Department of Corrections

1 shall be entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of length of
2 service, the continued custody and possession of the badge carried
3 by such officer immediately prior to retirement.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
