16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 2254, as
18	amended by Section 996, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp.
19	2018, Section 2254), is amended to read as follows:
20	Section 2254. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
21	revolving fund for the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department to
22	be designated the "State Park System Improvement Revolving Fund".
23	The fund shall be a continuing fund not subject to fiscal year
24	limitations. The fund shall consist of all monies that are received

1	by the Department, from all entrance or day-use charges for the
2	state park system, including charges for an annual pass for visitors
3	to the state parks. All monies accruing to the fund are hereby
4	appropriated and may be expended by the Department for the exclusive
5	purpose of capital improvements at the state park where the charges
6	were collected. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
7	warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
8	prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
9	Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
